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Updated First Pres Nursery School COVID-19 Screening Procedures 6/2/2021

Following new guidelines that we have received from the NJ Department of Children & Families; we are making changes to the daily screening procedures.

Because this is a year like no other, we are asking all parents to continue to err on the side of caution by not sending children to FPNS who are symptomatic for Covid-19, sick or generally feel unwell. We now have the option to have parents complete the screening questions and take their child's temperature at home prior to arrival at FPNS. The student's temperature must be below 100.4. At arrival we will ask you **"Is there any reason that your child should not be attending school today?"**.

If you answer "No", then you are attesting that none of the items below pertains to your child or family.

- The student has had a fever during the previous 24-hour period. Children must be FEVER FREE for 24-HOURS prior to coming to school WITHOUT THE USE OF FEVER REDUCING MEDICATION (i.e. Tylenol or Motrin).
- The student had close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- The student has a cough or shortness of breath.
- The student is having trouble breathing.
- The student has a headache, fever, muscle pain, and or chills.
- The student has a new loss of taste or smell.
- The student exhibits **ANY** of the other following Covid-19 symptoms: sore throat, nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, congestion/runny nose.
- The student lives in a household with someone who has a fever, cough, or shortness of breath.
- The student lives in a household with someone exhibiting 2 or more Covid-19 symptoms which are - cough, trouble breathing, shortness of breath, headache, fever, muscle aches, chills, new loss of taste or smell.
